THE DREAM (Mission)

Common Change is committed to empowering individuals to pool resources with people they know, to share with people they love and care about. We are committed to demonstrating that we live in an economy of abundance and to eliminating personal economic isolation.

YOUR ROLE

Generosity Dinners are opportunities for interested individuals to gather in a comfortable and personable "home" environment, share a meal, and participate in a giving experiment. Generosity Dinners introduce individuals to the Common Change model, demonstrating in a hands-on way how giving groups work, and exploring the underlying principles of collaborative giving.

We're looking for a vibrant and imaginative person, with a healthy sprinkling of administrative skills, to join us in inspiring others to a lifestyle of generosity. If connecting with people and giving them the tools to experience and experiment with generosity in innovative ways is your idea of fun, then we're your kind of people.

- 1. Curate Resources: develop and refine Generosity Dinner resources that will equip and mobilize individuals to give in more engaged and relationally-connected ways
 - a. Source or develop resources for use by Decision-Makers, Hosts, and Guests explaining what Generosity Dinners are and how they work
 - b. Develop multi-content social media resources, handouts, etc that people can use to spread the word about Generosity Dinners
 - c. Create compelling content that communicates stories of previous dinners/what to expect (needs met, participant testimonials, blog stories)
- 2. Coordinate Generosity Dinners: administrate dinners including sending Host resources, coordinating dinner fund contributions, sending prep emails, answering questions, designing and sending gift surveys to guests, prepping benevolences for account processing, and following up with guests on how their dinner helped.
 - a. Focus on the following stakeholders:
 - Individuals people wanting to gather friends and/or family to a dinner
 - New Groups new Common Change groups who want to get the ball rolling by launching with a dinner
 - Congregations or other groups of groups who want to experiment as a community by hosting community-wide dinners
 - Cities focusing in on specific geographic areas to mobilize multiple dinners to happen on a single day
